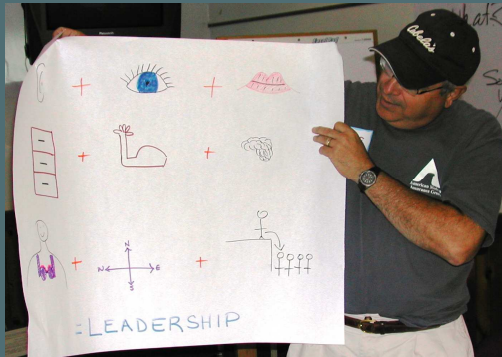

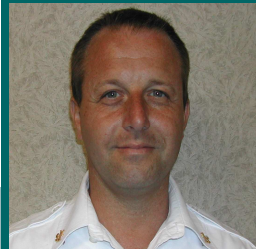
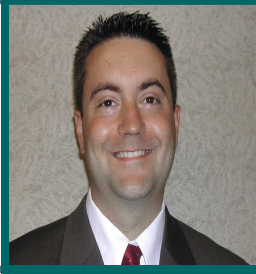
In addition to LEAD Clermont, the Leadership Development Programs are comprised of LIVE Clermont, Educational Leadership, and Look to Clermont.

# LEAD CLERMONT

LEAD Clermont is a unique leadership opportunity designed to enhance the development of future leaders for Clermont County. LEAD Clermont class members explore critical issues with knowledgeable speakers, effective facilitators, and a variety of experiential activities.

## PROGRAM GOALS

- To connect with the people, infrastructures and services that make the county work.
- To recognize a personal leadership style that promotes a more fulfilling work experience.
- To improve the quality of life in Clermont County through active participation in team projects.



## TIME COMMITMENT

- Program orientation in July
- Two-day teambuilding retreat in August
- Full-day class meetings the first Thursday of each month September through April
- Leadership Day in May
- Complete team project
- Participate in planning of one class day
- Graduation in July

## ATTENDANCE POLICY

Time invested in LEAD Clermont is both valuable and meaningful. Class members must be willing to devote a substantial amount of time to the LEAD Clermont class experience. Participants may not miss more than two class meetings, two project meetings or one class day planning meeting.

## ELIGIBILITY

Class members must reside or transact business in Clermont County for a minimum of one year and demonstrate:

- high standards of personal quality and integrity;
- sincere interest and possess a record of active involvement in community activities and issues;
- an occupation or position that reflects achievement relative to age and experience.



## CREDITS

Accredited through the University of Cincinnati-Clermont College, the course study requires varied reading assignments related to the program topics and active participation in all sessions. Participants earn 7 undergraduate credit hours through the University of Cincinnati-Clermont College. The investment for this year-long leadership program is \$1,750.

## ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Each year a group of twenty-six business and community leaders are selected to participate in LEAD Clermont.
