1. 18 years old
2. Assessment Test
3. Need high school counselor and
parents signatures

Degrees:

1. Bachelor's Degree (four years)

Admission Requirements:

1. Must graduate high school
2. Must meet high school college requirements

GRADUATE/PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL

Degrees:

1. Masters Degree
2. Doctorate or PhD

Admission Requirements:

1. Must first complete Bachelor and/or Masters

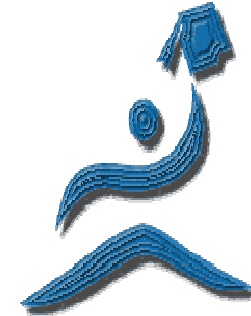

Clermont Educational Opportunities (CEO) and the Clermont County Public Library (CCPL) are committed to raising the awareness of postsecondary opportunities and encouraging all citizens, youth AND adults, to pursue some form of higher education after high school.

CEO is partnering with CCPL and opening Resource Centers in several branch locations. Each location provides free access to an online college and career information database, resource information on colleges, universities, technical schools and certification programs, scholarship searches, financial aid information and career development resources.

The College Access & Career Resource Centers give residents access to **free one-on-one guidance** from trained CEO College Access Advisors who can offer valuable information on all issues related to accessing postsecondary education.
