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CLEANUP GUIDELINES

1. Stay off the road surface (walk on the shoulder, grass, or edge).
2. **DO NOT** cross the road without permission.
3. Wear shirt, shoes, and gloves at all times.
4. Volunteers must stay within 50 ft. of each other at all times.
5. **DO NOT** pick up or touch dead animals, syringes, condoms, soiled diapers, and/or feminine hygiene products.
6. Do not put filled trash bags in front of guardrails, driveways, and/or mailboxes.
7. Tie off all filled bags securely and place 2 ft. off the roadway.
8. Bags should not be filled with trash past 1/2 way or past the tearing point.
9. **DO NOT** throw any items at vehicles, persons, and/or property.
10. **DO NOT** play with or tease animals wild or tame.
11. Pick up any trash larger than a lottery ticket or items noticeable from the road.
12. **BE EXTREMELY CAREFUL** when picking up broken glass or metal AND when carrying bags containing those items.
13. Never carry filled bags over your shoulder on the back.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY
